

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 14 March 2018 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We inspected the provider on 25 April 2018 and judged them to be Inadequate. As a result of that judgement we have served a Welfare Requirements Notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Actions needed by 31 May 2018

ensure that a lead person for safeguarding is available at all times

ensure that the setting's policy regarding the use of mobile phones is enforced at all times, and that any non-compliance is challenged

improve the quality of teaching, for example, by supporting staff to develop the skills they need to help children make the best possible progress

ensure that effective supervisions of staff are in place, which supports staff and promotes the interests of children

ensure that an appropriately qualified and experienced manager is in place to take responsibility for the day-to-day running of the nursery

ensure that action is taken to repair the damaged parts of the outdoor area

so that they do not pose a risk of harm to children

ensure that the premises are adequately clean and do not pose a risk to children's health.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
