

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 18 October 2017 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

We served a notice which required that the provider to take the action below within the timescales set out.

Action needed

Supply documentation to Ofsted to enable the completion of relevant checks to assess continued suitability for registration by 20 February 2018.

The provider did not respond appropriately to the action set. We served a Welfare Requirements Notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Action needed

Supply documentation to Ofsted to enable the completion of relevant checks to assess continued suitability for registration by 1 May 2018.

A suitable response to the welfare requirements notice was received.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
