Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- Staff have a clear understanding of how to protect children. They understand the possible signs and symptoms of abuse and have clear reporting procedures in place.
- Staff demonstrate a clear knowledge of how to work in partnership with other agencies. Procedures are in place to provide parents with daily feedback about what their children have done and their relationships with other children.
- Provision is in place for all children to receive one to one care to support their individual needs.
- The provider ensures that staff receive guidance and training so that they are confident in their roles and know how to address any concerns about children's welfare.
- Staff understand the benefits of giving children choices about their care and activities. They know how to provide suitable resources and experiences to cater for children's individual needs and interests.
- Staff know how to develop positive relationships with children to help them feel confident and secure at the setting.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector looked at the setting's policies and procedures and records.
- The inspector checked evidence of staff suitability and qualifications to work with children.
- The inspector took a tour of the setting with the team leader and looked at areas she intends to use for early years children.
- The inspector took the setting's self-evaluation and development plans into consideration.
- The inspector held meetings with the manager, team leader and staff during the inspection.
