The provision meets requirements

- The qualified provider understands the importance of ensuring all staff understand their roles and responsibilities. She discusses practice and identifies any training needs.
- The provider demonstrates a good understanding of the safeguarding requirements. She is aware of how to respond to an allegation being made against a staff member.
- The provider has a range of toys and resources available to promote children's interests. She knows how to offer an inclusive range of activities for children to explore.
- The provider understands the importance of keeping parents informed of all activities within the setting and of gathering information from them regarding their child's individual needs.
- The provider knows how to help children to learn how to lead a healthy lifestyle. She understands the importance of providing children with opportunities to participate in physical activities.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
