Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The provider demonstrates that she is aware that self-evaluation contributes towards improving outcomes for children.
- The provider understands her responsibility to safeguard children. Staff's knowledge of child protection is up to date and staff know what to do should they have any concerns about a child's welfare or safety.
- The provider is aware of working in close partnership with parents and other professionals. Staff know how to keep parents well informed about what is being provided for children. This helps to provide continuity in children's care.
- Staff are using the learning and development requirements well to guide their practice. A varied range of resources for indoor and outdoor use help to support children's development across all age groups.
- Staff demonstrate an understanding of how to offer an inclusive service and help children to learn about good behaviours. They know how to teach children to understand about tolerance and respect.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector viewed the areas of the school that she uses for children's care.
- The inspector and manager discussed the resources and equipment that she intends to use.
- The inspector held discussions with the manager about her knowledge and understanding of the safeguarding and welfare requirements.
- The inspector looked at relevant documentation, such as suitability checks and training certificates.
