Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a suitable knowledge of the early years foundation stage requirements. She understands the risks to children and the correct procedures to follow to help safeguard their welfare.
- The childminder knows how to assess and promote children's learning to help them make good progress. She understands how to help children gain the skills they need for their future learning, such as good communication, independence and confidence.
- The childminder understands how to work with parents to support children's emotional well-being, and to help children to develop healthy lifestyles and positive behaviour. She knows how to provide a safe and suitable premises and resources.
- The childminder recognises the importance of self-evaluation and professional development to make improvements to the outcomes for children. For example, she has increased the range of natural resources for children to explore, and includes mathematical language more to support this area of learning in play.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector held discussions with the childminder to assess her knowledge of the early years foundation stage requirements, and improvements made since the last inspection.
- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she intends to promote children's learning and development.
- The inspector looked at the documents the childminder plans to use when caring for children and discussed her policies.
- The inspector looked at the space available for childminding and the resources the childminder will use.
