The provision meets requirements

The childminder knows what procedures to follow if she has any concerns about a child's safety or welfare.
- The childminder knows how to support children's learning and development. She understands the importance of working with parents and others involved in children's care to ensure continuity in their care and learning.
- The childminder understands the importance of teaching children about the diversity of the wider world. She knows how to help prepare children to move on to school.
- The childminder understands the value of a healthy lifestyle. She provides a variety of nutritious meals and snacks, and encourages children to be physically active, for instance, through playing energetic games outdoors.
- The childminder knows how to promote positive behaviour and support children to develop their emotional well-being.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children.
