## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The very well-qualified manager understands how to meet the welfare requirements. She discusses how she intends to train and monitor staff to ensure they know how to identify and report any child protection concerns, including whistle blowing.
- The manager understands how to use policies and procedures to help keep children safe and secure, including the use of risk assessments and checks on staff practice.
- The manager knows the importance of sharing information with parents to keep them informed about their children's time at the club and to identify and support children's individual needs.
- The manager understands how to help children develop healthy lifestyles and plans to provide healthy snacks and physical activities daily. The manager understands how to help children learn to stay safe and behave well.
- The manager understands how to nurture children's emotional well-being. She knows how to promote children's self-esteem and social relationships.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
