## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The manager and staff have up-to-date knowledge of child protection matters and know what to do if they have any concerns about a child's welfare.
- Staff understand the importance of managing children's behaviour and teaching them how to get on with others and to accept differences between people.
- The manager and staff know how to plan a range of stimulating and exciting activities that meets children's interests and supports their play and learning.
- Management and staff understand how to reflect on their practice and use ongoing self-evaluation to identify the club's strengths and priorities for improvement.
- The manager and staff recognise the importance of building effective partnerships with parents and the schools children attend, to meet children's needs and continuity of care.
- Staff know how to support children to lead healthy lifestyles and learn about good hygiene routines. They recognise the importance of undertaking effective risk assessments to keep children safe.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Blue Bears Playscheme registered in 2015. It operates from Starks Field Primary School, in the London Borough of Enfield. The after-school club operates during term time, on Monday to Friday from 3pm to 5.45pm. It employs three members of staff, who hold relevant childcare qualifications at level 2 and 3.
