Summary of key findings for parents

The provision does not meet requirements

- The childminder does not meet all the safeguarding and welfare requirements. Although she is aware of what to do if she is worried about a child's welfare, she has not updated her knowledge on wider safeguarding issues. She does not have the required written statement of procedures to be followed for the protection of children.
- The childminder demonstrates through discussion and the sharing of documents, such as a progress check of a child between two and three years of age, she has a suitable understanding of the learning and development requirements.
- The childminder understands the importance of teaching children how to keep safe. She demonstrates a clear understanding of how to keep risks to a minimum.
- The childminder demonstrates through discussion and the sharing of documents how she communicates and works in partnership with parents. Parents report positively about the inclusive childminding setting.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
