The provision meets requirements

- Leaders support staff through regular supervision meetings to improve their practice and identify training needs, and to check their ongoing suitability.
- Staff know how to promote positive behaviour and keep children safe.
- Leaders are committed to developing the service and include the views of the parents and children when planning for future improvements.
- Leaders and staff understand the importance of promoting healthy lifestyles. Menus include healthy and nutritious choices.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. Byron Play Plus is an out-of-school centre run by Croydon Play Plus. The centre operates from a purpose built building in the grounds of Oasis Academy Byron in Coulsdon, Surrey. The centre employs four members of childcare staff. Of these, two hold relevant qualifications at level 3. The centre opens from Monday to Friday during term time. Sessions are from 3pm and 6pm. The centre also opens from 8am until 6pm during school holidays.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the early years foundation stage.

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
