

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of complaint

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

The provider notified us of a breach of the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage (EYFS). The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage welfare requirements to notify Ofsted of significant events that is likely to affect the suitability of the early year provider.

We conducted an unannounced visit and found that the provider had taken swift and effective action to rectify the breaches. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of complaints

We publish details of complaints made against childminders, home childcarers and childcare providers where we or the provider have taken action in order to meet legal requirements.

We publish details of complaints for five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
