

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of complaint

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 13 June 2018 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We visited the provider to discuss the concerns and have issued a Notice to Improve. This is a notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Action required:

3.54

ensure that the premises are safe and fit for purpose; this relates to clearing rubbish and broken toys from the outdoor area and ensuring that the pirate ship is maintained to a good standard - by 17 July 2018

3.64

improve risk assessment of the outdoor area and take all reasonable steps to ensure that children are not exposed to risks - by 17 July 2018.
