Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a secure knowledge of safeguarding and has appropriate policies in place. She is able to recognise signs of abuse and knows how to escalate concerns.
- The childminder offers a safe and engaging environment for young children. She provides resources, indoors and outdoors, to challenge children's physical development and promote creativity.
- The childminder understands the importance of completing observations and assessments to ascertain children's starting points, specific interests and to monitor their development. The childminder discusses how she will use this information, alongside the early years foundation stage, to plan effective next steps in learning.
- The childminder explains the importance of self-evaluation to continually enhance her practice. She is eager to attend ongoing training to keep her knowledge up to date.
- The childminder is aware of the importance of building strong partnerships with parents and external agencies to provide consistency for all children in their learning and development.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
