## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The premises are safe and secure. The provider and staff know how to conduct risk assessments to minimise hazards and maintain ratios to support children's safety. They keep relevant records for the safe management of the children and the club.
- The provider understands how to support children's good health and the importance of providing children with healthy meals, fresh air and exercise.
- The provider knows how to check staff's suitability, support them in their role and evaluate practice to raise standards.
- The provider and staff demonstrate an understanding of child protection issues and how to report concerns regarding children's welfare.
- The provider understands how to work cooperatively with parents, carers and the schools to promote continuity of care and learning for children.
- The provider knows how to provide activities to support children's learning and complement their experiences at school.
- The provider knows how to promote positive behaviour.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## **Inspection activities**

- The inspector went on a tour of the club with the provider and discussed safety arrangements.
- The inspector spoke to the provider and manager about the setting's practices and procedures, including safeguarding arrangements.
- The inspector looked at samples of documentation, which includes the risk assessment and safeguarding procedures, staff records, accident records and the public liability insurance certificate.
