

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

On 13 June 2018, the provider notified us of a required matter. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the early years foundation stage welfare requirements to notify Ofsted of significant incidents. We carried out a visit and have served a notice to improve. The provider is required to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 4 August 2018:

take steps to regularly review your risk assessments to ensure they are effective in minimising risk, specifically when new procedures have been implemented following a serious incident or accident

ensure staffing arrangements meet the needs of children and ensure their safety, specifically by effectively deploying staff so that all children are supervised well.

The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
