- The childminder understands how to promote children's health and well-being. She describes how she will encourage children to keep healthy, for example, by exercising outdoors and providing nutritious meals.
- The childminder understands the importance of sharing information with parents to provide a consistent approach to children's learning and care.
- The childminder recognises the importance of evaluating the service she provides. She describes how she will use feedback from parents and children to help her identify areas for improvement.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation.
