## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The manager understands how to plan activities to support children's individual needs and interests.
- The manager understands the importance of training the staff to be vigilant of the signs and symptoms that may cause a concern about the welfare of a child, and informs them of the procedures to follow for reporting any concerns.
- The manager knows how to support healthy lifestyles and children's understanding of hygiene practices, such as through the daily routines and providing regular opportunities for physical activity.
- The manager understands the importance of working in partnership with parents and other professionals, to support children's overall care and learning needs.
- The manager recognises the importance of evaluating her practice. She regularly engages with her staff, to support them to gain training and drive improvement. She liaises with her local authority to keep herself and the staff fully informed.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## **Inspection activities**

- The inspector engaged in discussions with the manager about her understanding of delivering and complementing the early years foundation stage and her practice.
- The inspector observed all areas of the club used for children.
- The inspector sampled a range of documentation, including the manager's and staff's training certificates, and written policies and procedures. She checked the staff's suitability and discussed the systems for self-evaluation.

Spring Meadows after-school club registered in 2010. It operates from a classroom within The John Warner School in Hoddesdon, Hertfordshire. The club employs eight members of childcare staff. Of these, three hold appropriate childcare qualifications at level 3 or above. The club opens from Monday to Friday during term time. Sessions are from 3.30pm until 6pm.
