## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The staff team are well qualified and experienced. Staff know how to effectively safeguard children and understand what to do if they have concerns about children's welfare. They access regular training to help them keep their knowledge up to date.
- Staff understand the importance of carrying out regular risk assessments to minimise hazards and provide a safe environment that promotes children's general well-being.
- Children have access to a range of toys and resources and staff understand how to plan activities that will interest and challenge children.
- Staff understand how to positively manage children's behaviour.
- Staff work closely with parents and the school. They ensure all relevant information is shared to support the continued care and learning needs of the children.
- Staff understand the importance of helping children to live healthy lifestyles. They provide children with nutritious snacks and encourage them to be physically active.
- Parents and children's views are taken into account when evaluating the provision and are used by managers to further develop the service they provide.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## **Inspection activities**

- The inspector had a tour of the areas used by children at the club.
- The inspector held discussions with the managers and staff. She checked evidence of the suitability of staff working with the children.
- The inspector sampled a range of documentation, including policies and procedures.
- The inspector observed the safety of the provision indoors and outdoors.

JJ's After School Club registered in 2005. The club employs four members of childcare staff, all of whom hold appropriate early years qualifications at levels 3 or above. The club opens from Monday to Friday during term time. Sessions are from 7.30am until 8.50am and 3.15pm until 5.30pm.
