#### Summary of key findings for parents

#### The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a confident knowledge of safeguarding. She has a clear understanding of how to report any concerns she may have about a child's safety and knows how to protect children from extreme views and beliefs.
- The childminder knows how to observe and monitor children's progress and explains how she plans for their individual next steps in learning. She knows how to manage children's behaviour positively.
- The childminder understands the importance of sharing information with parents and other settings that support children's individual care and learning needs.
- The childminder understands the significance of helping children to build on their skills to support their future learning. She explains the importance of encouraging children to develop their self-care and independence.
- The childminder understands how to evaluate her practice. She is aware of the benefits of professional development to help make ongoing improvements and enhance outcomes for children.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children.
