

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 10 July 2018 we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. We investigated and found that the provider had taken prompt and effective action to ensure the requirements were being met.

The action taken was to:

- to provide further training for staff in child protection with a focus on their PREVENT duty (Child protection 3.7)
 - to provide specific training on working with two-year-old children (Staff qualifications, training, support and skills 3.20)
 - to review and improve the recruitment procedures (Suitable people 3.9)
 - to reorganise the premises for two-year-olds in order to improve upon meeting their individual needs (Safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment)
- We are satisfied with the action taken by the provider and no further action was required by Ofsted on this matter. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
