Summary of key findings for parents

This provision meets requirements

- Staffing levels are in place that allow the provision of one-to-one care for all children and two-to-one care is provided when required.
- Staff are passionate and confident in their roles. They are well trained to care for children who have special educational needs and/or disabilities.
- Procedures are in place to monitor and develop staff performance, including daily reflective meetings, supervisory meetings and targeted training to meet specific needs of children.
- Staff understand the importance of getting to know children well and building secure relationships to help them to respond to their individual care and development needs.
- Staff have a good understanding of the possible signs and symptoms of abuse and know how to report any concerns they may have about the welfare of a child. They have a clear understanding of how to protect and safeguard children.
- Provision, such as specialist equipment, is in place for children to take part in a wide range of activities including regular trips into the local community.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector took a tour of the setting with the manager and looked at areas she intends to use for early years children.
- The inspector looked at the setting's policies and procedures and records.
- The inspector checked evidence of staff suitability and qualifications to work with children.
- The inspector took the setting's self-evaluation and development plans into consideration.
- The inspector spoke to staff and held meetings with the manager and team leader.
