#### This provision meets requirements

- The provider understands child protection issues and their responsibilities to promote children's safety and provide a secure environment. There are appropriate recruitment procedures that help to ensure staff are safe and suitable to work with the children.
- The provider demonstrates how to work in partnerships with parents. There are procedures in place to provide families with feedback about what children have participated in, for example, through daily conversations, a parent display board and feedback cards about the children's day.
- The provider is aware of how children learn and develop. They recognise the importance of observing children and planning activities based on their existing interests, in order to promote their enjoyment of learning and complement their personal experiences and interests.
- The provider is aware of the need to offer a welcoming environment to help children feel secure and settle with ease in the setting, and to ensure that this positively supports their emotional well-being.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
