Summary of key findings for parents

This provision meets requirements

- The childminder is aware of her responsibility to safeguard children. She understands how to identify children at risk of harm. She knows how to record and report concerns to appropriate agencies quickly to keep children safe.
- The childminder knows how to assess the progress children make. She intends to observe children's achievements closely and provide a range of activities to support children's progress.
- The childminder understands how to manage children's behaviour. For example, she knows that children respond well when there are clear boundaries in place and this helps children to develop a sense of security.
- The childminder recognises the need to continue to develop her skills. For instance, she is able to identify her own training needs and access the relevant training.
- The childminder understands the importance of partnership working, and sharing information with parents about their child's development, to help them to support their child's learning at home.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector viewed the areas of the childminder's home she intends to use for childminding.
- The inspector discussed the childminder's understanding of the learning and development, and safeguarding and welfare requirements of the early years foundation stage.
- The inspector reviewed documentation, including a selection of policies, risk assessments, certificates and evidence of the suitability of the childminder.
- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she intends to observe children, assess their progress and plan for their next steps in learning.
