## Summary of key findings for parents

### This provision meets requirements

- Staff understand all aspects of safeguarding matters. They receive training prior to working at the camp and update their knowledge on a regular basis. They understand their role and responsibility in keeping children safe.
- Staff plan and provide a range of varied activities and play opportunities to keep children of all ages and abilities occupied and to complement their learning at school.
- Super Camps' staff provide parents with information about their children's day. They ask parents to provide details of each child's individual needs to enable them to provide activities they will enjoy.
- Management supports staff and monitors their practice. Management and staff use the views of parents and children to adapt their daily planning and make ongoing improvements to the service they offer.
- The range of resources and equipment enables children to enjoy their chosen play indoors and outside.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

### **Inspection activities**

- The inspector had a meeting with the camp manager and the regional manager.
- The inspector viewed a range of documentation, including policies and procedures, risk assessments and staff qualifications.
- The inspector spoke to staff and older children at appropriate times during the inspection.
- The inspector viewed areas of the provision used by children and looked at a variety of resources used by younger children.

Super Camps at St Edwards Preparatory School registered in 2016. The setting operates from St Edwards Junior School in Cheltenham. The setting is open from 9am to 5pm each day during the Easter and summer school holidays. An extended day is optional and operates from 8am to 6pm. There are five staff and most hold qualified teacher status.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the early years foundation stage.

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
