## Summary of key findings for parents

### This provision meets requirements

- The manager recognises the importance of developing her own skills and those of her staff, and keeping up to date with new guidelines and requirements. For example, she has updated her safeguarding policy to include new information to keep children safe.
- The manager intends to reflect regularly on her practice and plans to seek the views of staff, children and parents to help improve the quality of her setting.
- The manager and staff know how to encourage children's good behaviour and support a healthy lifestyle.
- The manager has a good understanding of children's unique needs and intends to plan activities to keep them motivated to learn.
- The manager has a good understanding of the value of building relationships with the school and describes how she will work with parents to ensure consistency in meeting children's individual needs.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

### **Inspection activities**

- The inspector viewed the premises.
- The inspector and manager discussed her knowledge of safeguarding, risk assessments, children's needs and her self-evaluation.
- The inspector viewed the resources and talked to the manager about how she would use these to help to motivate children.

Clubland@ St Martins registered in 2012. It operates from St Martins School in Dorking, Surrey. It provides before- and after-school care from 7.15am to 9am and 3pm to 6pm during term times. There are 13 members of staff. Of these, three hold a recognised early years qualification.
