Summary of key findings for parents

This provision meets requirements

- The management team have addressed the actions raised at the last inspection. They understand how to evaluate the effectiveness of the club. The manager gathers the views of parents and children to help to identify ongoing improvements.
- The management team demonstrate their good knowledge of child protection procedures. They understand their responsibility to keep children safe from harm and have good systems in place to check staff's suitability to work with children.
- The management team and staff are qualified. They have a good understanding of how to provide interesting play activities for children that complement the learning that takes place at school.
- The management team demonstrate their good knowledge of how to support children who have special educational needs and/or disabilities. They understand how to promote children's positive behaviour.
- The management team demonstrate their clear understanding of how to provide children with nutritious snacks and a range of opportunities to be physically active. They are aware of the importance of helping children to develop healthy lifestyles.
- The management team show their good understanding of the importance of working in close partnership with parents. They explain ways to share information, in order to support consistency in children's care.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector viewed all areas of the premises where the club operates from. She discussed with the managers how they will organise the play resources to support the early years children when they attend.
- The inspector checked evidence of the suitability and qualifications of the manager and staff.
- The inspector discussed the club's self-evaluation process and checked the manager's understanding of the legal requirements.
- The inspector discussed the policies and procedures with the manager and viewed a range of other documentation that they plan to use when caring for children.

Fell Lane After School Club registered in 2001. The club employs three members of childcare staff. Of these, all hold appropriate early years qualifications at level 3. The club opens from Monday to Friday, term time only. Sessions are from 2.45pm until 5.45pm.
