## Summary of key findings for parents

#### This provision meets requirements

- The childminder is fully aware of her responsibilities to meet the safeguarding and welfare requirements. She knows the action to take if she has concerns about a child.
- The childminder has completed relevant training and keeps up to date with current childcare guidance and best practice. She explains how she evaluates her practice.
- The childminder understands how to promote children's good health and well-being. She ensures they eat suitable food and learn good hygiene practices.
- The childminder recognises the importance of working in partnership with parents and others who share the care of the children. She provides regular feedback about children's progress and care.
- The childminder shows she understands the need to teach children how to behave well and respect others.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
