Summary of key findings for parents

This provision meets requirements

- The childminder knows how to support children's learning and development. She understands how children learn and is aware of the importance of observing and assessing them to enable her to track and plan for their development and help them make progress.
- The childminder recognises the importance of working in partnership with parents and professionals involved in children's care and education to support continuity of care.
- The childminder is supportive of the children's health and well-being. For example, she understands the benefits of providing children with daily opportunities for fresh air and exercise.
- The childminder has a secure awareness of her roles and responsibilities to safeguarding children. She is confident in the referral procedures to follow if she is concerned about a child's welfare, if needed.
- The childminder realises the importance of keeping her training and skills up to date.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she plans to support and deliver the educational programmes for children.
