## Summary of key findings for parents

### This provision meets requirements

- The manager has a secure understanding of her responsibility to safeguard children, including how to check evidence of staff's suitability to work with children and report concerns regarding children's welfare.
- The manager has strategies to manage children's behaviour and to teach them to respect others.
- The manager recognises the importance of planning activities based on children's interests and requests, to help motivate them to develop their knowledge and skills.
- The manager knows how to identify and minimise potential hazards. The environment is safe for children. The manager understands how to support children's good health.
- The manager is aware of the importance of helping children to develop respect for each other and build good relationships. She knows how to support children to be independent, while gaining skills to help them to prepare for school.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

### **Inspection activities**

- The inspector looked at relevant documentation and discussed the self-evaluation, improvement plans, policies and procedures, and evidence of the suitability of staff working in the club.
- The inspector undertook a tour of the premises.
- The inspector sampled children's records and care information.
- The inspector held discussions with the provider regarding her knowledge of safeguarding and how to keep children safe in her care.

Mel's Gentle Butterflies registered in 2014 and operates from 8am to 6pm on Monday to Friday during all school holidays, except for the Christmas holidays. There are four members of staff, two of whom hold relevant childcare qualifications at level 3.
