Summary of key findings for parents

This provision meets requirements

- The leadership team and staff understand their roles and responsibilities in keeping children safe and protecting them from harm. They also recognise the importance of undertaking risk assessments to help children play in safety.
- The leadership team and staff have completed safeguarding training. They know the signs to look for and the procedures to follow if they have concerns about a child's welfare.
- Leaders and staff know how to provide an enjoyable range of physical, creative and imaginative experiences for children during the school holidays. Staff understand their responsibilities with regards to promoting children's health and well-being.
- Leaders understand the importance of gathering and collating the views of staff, parents and children to continually improve the service offered.
- Leaders and staff know how to help children understand behavioural expectations. They understand how to promote children's independence, self-esteem and physical development.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector held discussions with the deputy manager and staff to assess their knowledge of how they will deliver a range of activities for children.
- The inspector observed areas to be used for the care of children and discussed the programme of activities, equipment and toys used for children.
- The inspector reviewed a range of documentation covering children's information, policies and procedures, daily records and risk assessments.
- The inspector discussed the safeguarding and welfare requirements with the deputy manager and staff, and took into consideration the suitability checks.
