

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 29 June 2018 the provision was inspected and judged inadequate. Welfare Requirements Notice was issued to:

- ensure that at least one person who has a current paediatric first aid certificate accompanies children on outings
- record information about vetting processes that have been completed (including the criminal records disclosure, reference number, the date the disclosure was obtained and details of who obtained it)
- improve knowledge and understanding of the Early Years Foundation Stage and ensure all requirements are met so that children's safety and welfare is safeguarded
- implement effective arrangements for the monitoring, support and supervision of staff, to identify and act on weaknesses in practice to keep children safe
- ensure all hazards to children's health and safety are identified and eliminated, with particular regard to ensuring food is served at a safe temperature and security of the premises.

We made unannounced visits on 11 July 2018, 16 August and 19 September to monitor compliance with this. We are satisfied that the provider has met the Welfare Requirements Notice. The provider continues to be registered.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
