## Summary of key findings for parents

### This provision meets requirements

- The provider and manager understand the process for notifying Ofsted with regard to any changes in circumstances.
- The manager and staff understand their responsibility to keep children safe and protect them from harm. They understand how to recognise and report any child protection concerns.
- The manager recognises the importance of gathering the views of staff, parents and children to help evaluate and develop the club further.
- Staff know how to develop good partnership working with parents and the host school. They understand the importance of sharing information and keeping parents informed about their children's time at the club.
- Staff understand how to support children's good health, such as providing balanced, nutritious snacks and opportunities for exercise.
- Staff know how to promote children's good behaviour and understand the importance of setting clear boundaries for them to follow.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

### **Inspection activities**

- The inspector spoke to the manager and staff about the provision of care for the children and had a tour of the areas used by the children at the club.
- The inspector held discussions with the manager. She checked evidence of the suitability of staff working with the children.
- The inspector sampled a range of documentation, including policies and procedures, staff records and risk assessments.

Treetops Fun Club registered in 2016. It operates from Shobnall Primary School. There are four members of staff, three of whom hold appropriate qualifications at level 3. The club opens five days a week from 7.30am to 8.50am and from 3.20pm until 6pm during term time only.
