

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

At an inspection on 16 October 2018 we found the care being provided to be inadequate requiring enforcement action. We sent the provider, a notice to improve and a welfare requirement notice to comply with the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage.

Actions needed:

Staff qualifications, training, support and skills;

ensure at least one person who has a current paediatric first-aid certificate accompanies children when they are away from the setting. By 7 October 2018.

Suitable people;

implement effective systems to ensure all staff looking after children are suitable, which must include obtaining an enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service check. By 7 October 2018.

Suitable people;

ensure that all information is recorded about staff's qualifications, checks and vetting processes that have been completed, to establish the suitability of staff. By 7 October 2018.

Outings;

ensure all vehicles used to transport children are adequately insured. By 7 October 2018

We carried out a compliance visit on 8 November 2018, to check compliance with the welfare requirement notice . We found the provider had taken prompt and effective action to comply with the requirements.

We are satisfied with the action taken by the provider and no further action was required by Ofsted on this matter. The next step will be a full inspection. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
