## Summary of key findings for parents

### This provision meets requirements

The manager holds a relevant paediatric first aid certificate. She understands to inform Ofsted of any changes which may impact upon her registration.
- The manager has carefully considered how she evaluates the service she provides.
- The children are provided with a suitable environment, activities and resources. The manager understands how to complement the learning and activities children undertake in school.
- The manager understands the importance of working in partnership with parents and others involved in children's care, to meet their needs effectively.
- The manager understands the importance of putting suitable strategies in place to ensure all staff are suitable to work with children.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

It is open Monday to Friday from 3.30pm to 6pm during term time only. There are four members of staff, three of whom hold relevant qualifications at level 2 and level 3.
