# Summary of key findings for parents

#### This provision meets requirements

- Staff have a good knowledge and understanding of the early years foundation stage and they know how to promote children's learning and development.
- The premises are safe and secure. Staff demonstrate that they have clear safety procedures to reduce the risk of accidents and incidents.
- Staff understand the local safeguarding procedures and regularly refresh their training. They know the signs and symptoms that would cause them concern and how to respond appropriately.
- The provider and manager undertake robust recruitment and induction processes.
- Staff explain how they recognise the importance of promoting good behaviour, kindness and respect for others to help support children's personal development and their well-being.
- The manager is aware of the need to evaluate her practice. She seeks parents' and children's views and ensures her staff's knowledge is up to date through training.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

### **Inspection activities**

- The inspector had a tour of the premises available for use by children and saw the equipment and toys staff use with them.
- The inspector discussed with the manager how they intend to deliver the educational programmes for children.
- The inspector held meetings with the nursery manager and provider. She looked at relevant documentation and evidence of the suitability of staff working on the premises.
- The inspector took account of children's and parents' views through written questionnaires.

Cherubs@Wychwood registered in 2008. It is an out-of-school provision run by an adjacent private nursery. The club is open each weekday during school term times from 7.30am until 8.40am and from 3pm to 6pm. During school holidays it is open from 8am to 6pm depending on demand. If numbers are too low to provide holiday care at the school, places are made available at the private nursery. The club employs six staff. Of these, three staff hold relevant level 3 qualifications.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register. The registered person must ensure that this provision complies with the statutory framework for children's learning, development and care, known as the early years foundation stage.

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
