## Summary of key findings for parents

### This provision meets requirements

- The childminder knows child protection procedures and her responsibility to protect the safety and welfare of the children in her care. She understands how to recognise concerns and to record and report these, where appropriate.
- The childminder explains how she will use observation and assessment to track children's learning and development. She understands the need to complete the progress check for children aged between two and three years.
- The childminder knows how to encourage children to maintain a healthy lifestyle. She explains how she risk assesses her home, to help minimise hazards to children.
- The childminder knows the importance of establishing relationships with parents and other professionals, to help support children's care and learning.
- The childminder understands the need to continue building on her knowledge and skills. She explains how she reflects on her practice to help her make improvements.
- The childminder understands the importance of managing children's behaviour positively. She explains how she encourages children to respect the views and feelings of others.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

- The inspector discussed statutory requirements with the childminder to check her knowledge.
- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she delivers the educational programmes for children.
- The inspector sampled documentation, including policies and procedures.
