Summary of key findings for parents

This provision meets requirements

- The provider knows how to safeguard children. He understands the procedures to protect children from risk of harm and implements processes to keep staff's safeguarding knowledge up-to-date.
- The provider recognises the importance of evaluating the provision to help provide a safe and attractive environment for children. He understands the need to plan a variety of activities to interest and engage them in different experiences and develop their skills.
- The provider recognises the importance of working in partnership with parents and other settings that children attend, to provide consistent care and experiences for children.
- The provider knows how to build positive relationships with children, to support them to feel welcome and settled, and help them learn how to behave appropriately.
- The provider has a particularly clear understanding of the need to work closely with parents, schools and outside agencies, to provide individual support for children with special educational needs and/or disabilities.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
