Summary of key findings for parents

This provision does not meet requirements

- The provider fails to record details of suitability and vetting checks used for staff.
- The provider does not include information about the safe use of mobile phones and cameras in the safeguarding policy, as required.
- The provider demonstrates her understanding of the potential risks posed to children. She is clear about what action to take if concerns arise about their welfare.
- The provider explains how she intends to provide activities based on children's developmental needs and interests. She intends to gather information about children from the start and share assessments of their progress with parents.
- The provider recognises the importance of providing an inclusive service. She describes how she intends to work with parents and other professionals who may be involved, to help close any gaps in children's learning.
- The provider plans to seek the views of parents in order to develop her service.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

What the setting needs to do to improve further

The Woodland Nursery registered in 2017. It is located in the Kidbrooke area of the Royal Borough of Greenwich. The setting operates from 9am until 3.30pm, term time only. The manager holds an appropriate early years qualification at level 6. The nursery follows the forest-school approach to outdoor learning.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register.
