Summary of key findings for parents

This provision does not meet requirements

- The provider, who is also the manager, does not have documentation to demonstrate that she holds valid public liability insurance, as required.
- The provider understands how to plan a variety of activities, indoors and outdoors, to meet the age range of children who will attend the out-of-school club.
- The provider understands the importance of valuing the views of parents and children to continually evaluate her service.
- The provider keeps her safeguarding knowledge up to date. She knows the local reporting procedures to follow if she has a concern about a child's welfare.
- The provider understands how to support children's behaviour. She explains how she will use different approaches to support all children to behave well.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
