Summary of key findings for parents

This provision meets requirements

- The manager and staff understand about their responsibility to protect children's safety and welfare. They have completed relevant training and know how to recognise possible signs of abuse and report any concerns they have about a child's well-being.
- The manager and area manager talk about how they complete regular risk assessments. These cover all areas of the premises used by children and detail how they are safely collected from school. They are aware of how to identify potential risks and understand how to take action to minimise hazards.
- The manager describes how she and her staff support children's independence, self-esteem and confidence. She is aware of how to promote positive behaviour management. For example, she talks about how children are keen to gain points on the club's reward chart.
- The manager understands the importance of supporting partnerships with parents and other professionals. She discusses promoting a two-way exchange of information regarding children's care, well-being and ongoing interests.
- The manager describes how the provision of activities is based on children's level of ability and their ongoing interests. She speaks about how this helps to encourage them to take part and engage in play opportunities.
- The manager and staff know that regularly reviewing their practice helps them to ensure that they continue to meet requirements and identify any areas for future development, including training needs.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector discussed the safeguarding and welfare requirements with the manager and area manager. She also looked at relevant documentation, including evidence of the suitability of persons working with children.
- The inspector discussed with the manager how children are supported to take part in activities that interest them and help them develop.
- The inspector held discussions with the manager, area manager and staff about how they reflect on practice.
- The inspector held a number of discussions with the manager, area manager and staff. She discussed the club's policies and procedures and viewed documentation completed by parents that help staff to meet children's individual needs.
- The inspector toured the areas of the school premises that are used by children. She held discussions about children's safety and the equipment and toys available.

Energy Kidz Out of School Club - Reedings CM21 registered in 2016. The club employs two members of childcare staff. Of these, one holds an early years qualification at level 2. The club opens from Monday to Friday during term time only. Sessions are from 7.30am until 9am and from 2.45pm until 6pm.
