

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 29 November 2018 this provider was inspected and they received a judgement of inadequate. We served a welfare requirements notice. This is a legal notice that required the provider to take the actions detailed in the inspection report by 14 December 2018. We carried out a monitoring visit and found that although the provider had made some improvements with regards to staff knowledge and understanding of safeguarding procedures, they had not taken sufficient steps to meet all the actions in the notice. We have served a further welfare requirements notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

*ensure staff understand risk assessment procedures and can identify all potential hazards and take prompt and appropriate action to minimise any risk to children 25 January 2019

*provide all staff, including the manager, with support, training and coaching to ensure they have a good understanding of their roles and responsibilities, and have opportunities to gain the knowledge and skills they need to carry out their roles successfully 25 January 2019.

We are satisfied with the action the provider has taken. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.
