Summary of key findings for parents

This provision meets requirements

- The childminder is familiar with how to identify and report any concerns she has about children's safety and welfare. She knows how to keep her knowledge of child protection up to date to ensure she can report any concerns promptly.
- The childminder understands how to support children's learning and development. She knows how to observe, plan and assess children's achievements to ensure they make progress and are prepared for their eventual move to school.
- The childminder recognises the importance of developing strong partnerships with parents.
- The childminder has a wide variety of toys and resources to appeal to a variety of ages and stages of learning.
- The childminder knows the importance of evaluating her provision to improve outcomes for children.
- The childminder demonstrates that she understands how to plan activities which engage children's interests.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
