## Summary of key findings for parents

### This provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands the early years foundation stage and knows the ways in which to promote learning in young children. She knows a range of ways to support children in managing their feelings and behaviour.
- The childminder understands how to safeguard children. She knows what her responsibilities are, and the steps she will take if she has a concern about a child in her care.
- The childminder recognises the importance of close partnerships with parents and other professionals. She understands her responsibilities in assessing children's learning and development and how to share this information with the necessary people.
- The childminder keeps her premises safe and removes any risks to children.
- The childminder describes how she will observe and assess children's learning. She is able to explain how she will provide appropriate learning experiences to help them make progress.
- The childminder knows how to evaluate her provision and regularly updates her knowledge and understanding in all areas of the early years foundation stage.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

### **Inspection activities**

- The inspector sampled a range of relevant documentation, including the childminder's qualifications and training certificates, and information records.
- The inspector discussed with the childminder her knowledge of the early years foundation stage requirements.
- The inspector looked at the areas of the house used for childminding.
