

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

As a result of our inspection on 23 January 2019, we issued a Welfare Requirements Notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to comply with The Safeguarding and welfare requirements of the statutory framework for the early years foundation stage. In particular, Child protection, Premises, Suitable people, Health, and Staff training, support and skills. During a monitoring visit on the 20 February 2019, the inspector found that staff have attended child protection training and know where to report concerns. Steps have been implemented to ensure unauthorised persons cannot enter the building. All staff now hold an up-to-date disclosure and barring service check and hygiene practices are much improved. The manager and deputy now monitor planning and provide support and training to enable staff to provide quality learning experiences for children. The inspector concluded that sufficient action has been taken to meet the Welfare Requirements Notice, therefore, no further action is required.
