This provision does not meet requirements

- The provider has not put appropriate procedures in place for the effective supervision of staff and to support their professional development.
- Through discussions, the manager and staff show that they have a suitable understanding of the safeguarding procedures to follow should they become concerned about a child's safety.
- The manager and staff recognise the importance of working in partnership with parents. They understand the need to share regular information to help provide a consistent approach in meeting children's needs.
- The manager demonstrates that there are sound recruitment and vetting procedures in place to ensure that staff are suitable to work with children.
- The manager and staff provide an environment and resources to support children's independent play and complement their learning in school. Staff explain how they allow children to make choices and how they involve children in the planning of the activities.
- The manager and staff demonstrate a good understanding of how to support children to behave appropriately. Children are involved in creating and agreeing the rules of the club.
- The manager explained her understanding of how to support children's healthy development, such as through providing nutritious food and daily opportunities for physical exercise.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
