Summary of key findings for parents

This provision meets requirements

- The childminder understands her duty to safeguard children and protect them from harm. She knows how to refer concerns to the correct local agencies.
- The childminder keeps her premises safe and removes any risks to children.
- The childminder understands the importance of working in partnership with parents to provide continuity of care for children.
- The childminder holds a paediatric first-aid qualification. She has a good understanding of meeting children's needs in the event of an emergency or accident.
- The childminder understands the importance of providing children with exercise and a healthy diet, including meeting their dietary needs.
- The childminder understands how to manage children's behaviour and help children follow rules and boundaries. She discusses how to help children respect each other's differences.
- The childminder demonstrates a clear understanding of the learning and development requirements. She knows how to observe and assess children's progress and plan for their next steps in learning.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector held discussions with the childminder about her childcare practices.
- The inspector sampled a range of relevant documentation, including the childminder's qualifications and information records.
- The inspector discussed with the childminder how she intends to deliver the educational programmes for children and undertake observations, assessment and planning.
- The inspector had a tour of the areas of the premises intended for use by children.
