

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

1. early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, (EYFS) which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

During a visit on 10 April 2019 we identified that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. Following the visit, we have issued a Notice to Improve. This is a notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Actions needed:

ensure all staff have suitable training to enable them to manage children's behaviour in an age-appropriate manner that supports children's emotional well-being by 24 April 2019

ensure the safeguarding policy includes a clear explanation of the action to be taken in the event of an allegation being made against a member of staff by 24 April 2019

ensure required records are easily accessible and available to view, particularly with regard to complaints by 24 April 2019

improve arrangements for the supervision of all staff who have contact with children and families; ensure supervision provides support, coaching and training for staff and promotes a culture of mutual support and teamwork by 10 May 2019

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
