Summary of key findings for parents

This provision meets requirements

- The provider understands her role in safeguarding and protecting children from harm. She is familiar with wider safeguarding and child protection issues. She knows the procedures to report any concerns, including allegations, to the relevant authorities.
- The provider knows to carry out risk assessments to identify hazards in the environment and understands her responsibility to supervise children well. She maintains a safe environment for children to play.
- The provider knows how to promote children's good health. She recognises how to support children's healthy lifestyles. The provider understands how to provide healthy snacks, meals and daily opportunities for children to enjoy fresh air and exercise.
- The provider understands how to positively manage children's behaviour, encourage children to use good manners and to show respect to each other.
- The provider understands the importance of providing children with a range of stimulating activities to reflect their individual interests and challenge their abilities.
- The provider explains how she ensures safe recruitment and ongoing suitability of staff. She provides staff with inductions and monitors their work. She recognises the value of professional development to enhance their knowledge and skills.
- The provider recognises how good information sharing with parents and the school helps her to build strong and positive partnerships and ensures consistency of care.
- The provider understands how evaluating her provision helps her to identify improvements. She includes the views of staff, children and parents in this process to help decide the activities she provides for children.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector had a tour of the club. She looked at the security arrangements to keep children safe.
- The inspector held discussions with the provider and supervisor at appropriate times throughout the inspection.
- The inspector sampled a selection of documentation relating to safeguarding and staff suitability, as well as policies and procedures.
- The inspector discussed with the provider her plans for improvement and how she evaluates her provision.
- The inspector discussed the range of activities and opportunities that would be available for children.

Active Bodies at Hatton registered in 2018. The club operates from a classroom in Heath Fields Primary School, Hatton, Derbyshire. It is open Monday to Friday during term time only. Sessions are from 7.30am until 8.50am and 3.15pm until 6pm. The club employs four members of staff, all whom hold appropriate early years qualifications at level 2 and 3.

This inspection was carried out by Ofsted under sections 49 and 50 of the Childcare Act 2006 on the quality and standards of provision that is registered on the Early Years Register.
