

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at <u>www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2</u>. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 3 April 2019, we received information that the provider was not meeting the requirements. On 7 May 2019, we carried out a visit to the Out of School provision. We found the provider had failed to notify Ofsted of changes to circumstances, the manager and a significant event. We discussed these breaches with the provider's representative and acknowledge that they had overlooked the requirement to notify Ofsted. We are satisfied there was no intent to deceive Ofsted. The provider remains registered with Ofsted.

Publication of complaints

We publish details of complaints made against childminders, home childcarers and childcare providers where we or the provider have taken action in order to meet legal requirements.

We publish details of complaints for five years commencing on the date we complete our investigation.
